Welcome to the **Missouri Online Summer Institute!**

Are you looking for a creative and engaging summer school option? Maybe your school doesn't offer summer school or there are conflicts with your program's schedule. If so, we have the solution!

The Missouri Online Summer Institute (MOSI) is a free virtual summer school program open to all Missouri students in grades 7-12. We offer more than 100 courses for original credit and credit recovery, including those state required electives of physical education, personal finance and health. We also offer multiple CTE introductory courses in several career clusters as well as several AP courses.

Here is how the program works:

- Students can enroll in up to four courses for (up to a total of 2 credits).
- There is an orientation process for students and parents/learning coaches to promote success in an online course.
- Students work at their own pace with the assistance of a state certified teacher and a dedicated advisor.
- Students have access to an online classroom to interact with teachers and other students.
- Upon completion of the course, we send course information back to the student's district. Transcripts will be sent within one week for courses completed before July 7th and within two weeks for courses completed after that date.

Enrollment is now open and students can begin courses as soon as May 22nd depending on when their current school year finishes. All courses will close on July 21st. The good news is that MOSI is a free program. There is no cost to the student or district. Students are responsible for providing their own computer and internet service to access the courses.

Students are not allowed to enroll in MOSI if they are taking a summer school course at your district. We will be contacting the student's district as part of the enrollment process to certify the eligibility of each student who wants to enroll.

Included in the Enrollment Packet are the High School and Middle School Course List and a Course Approval Form. A school guidance counselor or administrator must complete and sign the Course Approval Form if a student wants to take either an AP or credit recovery course. MOSI is a free virtual summer school program offering more than 70 courses for original credit or credit recovery. Courses are either one semester (0.5 credits) or two semesters (1.0 credit) in length as indicated in the course list (■ or ■■). Students may enroll in 1-4 courses up to a total of two credits. Students are responsible for providing their own computer and internet access. MOSI is open to all Missouri students in grades 6-12.

IMPORTANT: According to Section 167.227 RSMO, “No pupil shall attend summer school courses in more than one district during any one summer.” Students who enroll in MOSI may not enroll in and attend summer school courses at another district, and students who enroll in another summer school program are ineligible to enroll in MOSI.
